Field of expertise:	Development Economics, with a focus on, and relevance for, developing Asian countries. Ability to design and teach courses related to Economics, Development Studies, and Social Analysis.
Academic Rank:	Assistant Professor to Associate Professor, based on experience.
Start Date:	August 19, 2018; 1-year contract, renewable based on satisfactory performance.
Gross Compensation Package:	Starting at USD 33,000 – 45,000 per annum (based on rank); Including benefits – deferred compensation, accommodation, annual travel, health insurance. Non-Bangladeshi citizens eligible for income tax exemption in Bangladesh.

Required Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree in Economics, with a specialization in Development Economics or related field, from a recognized university.
- Evidence of teaching excellence.
- Excellent quantitative and analytical skills using statistical packages.
- Excellent written and communication skills.
- Ability to communicate with others through speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Duties:

- Plan, develop, and teach courses and seminars for undergraduate students with Economics major and Development Studies minor, as well as Social Analysis courses for the General Education Requirement.
- Serve as academic advisor and mentor to students.
- Supervise students in developing and implementing senior thesis projects including guiding them in data analysis, thesis writing and presentation.
- Attract funding and engage in research.
- Provide leadership and service on academic committees.

Teaching requirement: six 4-credit courses per academic year; expected to teach: *History of Economic Thought, Political Economy, Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Economic Development in Conflict Areas, Regional Challenges, etc.*
