Duties:

- The appointed faculty will take the lead in reviewing and updating the program curriculum, with a view to a complementary focus on subject areas common to Environmental Science and Public Health
- Plan, develop, and teach courses and seminars for undergraduate students across all levels.
- Serve as academic advisor and mentor to students.
- Supervise students in developing and implementing senior thesis projects including guiding them in data analysis, thesis writing and presentation.
- Attract funding and engage in research.
- Provide leadership and service on academic committees.
