<b>Field of expertise:</b>	Any natural science, with ability to design and teach courses on Evolution, Biodiversity, Anatomy & Physiology, Bioethics, and topics such as Women in Science. The ability to teach Evolution is highly desired, with a focus on relevance to Asia.
<b>Academic Rank:</b>	Ranging from Assistant Professor to Associate Professor, based on experience.
<b>Start Date:</b>	August 19, 2018; 1-year contract, renewable based on satisfactory performance.
<b>Gross Compensation Package:</b>	Starting at USD 33,000 – 42,000 per annum (based on rank); Included benefits – deferred compensation, accommodation, annual travel, health insurance. Non-Bangladeshi citizens eligible for income tax exemption in Bangladesh.

### Required Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in a field of Natural Sciences.
- Evidence of teaching excellence.
- Excellent quantitative and analytical skills.
- Excellent written and communication skills.
- Ability to communicate with others through speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

### Duties:

- Plan, develop, and teach courses and seminars for undergraduate students across all levels, including courses in pre-University level, General Education Requirement and upper level Major and Minor courses.
- Serve as academic advisor and mentor to students.
- Supervise students in developing and implementing senior thesis projects including guiding them in data analysis, thesis writing and presentation.
- Attract funding and engage in research.
- Provide leadership and service on academic committees.

Teaching requirement: six 4-credit courses per academic year; expected to teach: *Evolution, Biodiversity, Anatomy & Physiology, Bioethics, Women in Science.*
