

Sample English Questions for the AUW Admissions Test

Applicants will take a 90-minute English test aligned with the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), the global standard for assessing language proficiency.

The test comprises two sections: a 100-question multiple-choice (MCQ) task and a two-question writing assessment. Samples of question types from both sections are provided below:
